

Roger Allen Park No Alcohol or Tobacco Policy

Effective March 19, 2008, the Roger Allen Park Board of Directors has unanimously voted to designate the entire park as an alcohol and tobacco-free zone at all times, without exception.

Roger Allen Park was established as a safe environment for the youth athletes of Rochester and surrounding areas to learn and play the sports they love. The park is designed to foster good sportsmanship and help develop positive habits in sports and life. Therefore, the consumption of alcohol in any form is strictly prohibited on park grounds. Additionally, the use of tobacco products, including cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, and e-cigarettes, is strictly forbidden at all times.

Failure to comply with this policy will result in immediate dismissal from the park, potential banning from future entrance, and possible involvement of law enforcement.

Please help us maintain a safe, fun, and exemplary environment for our youth athletes by refraining from using alcohol or tobacco products while on park premises.
